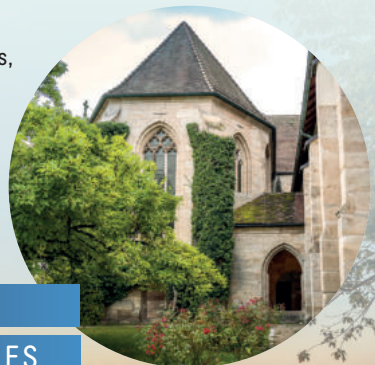

WONDERFUL HIKING AND CYCLE TRAILS, UNIQUE OUTDOOR EXPERIENCES

The 215-km-long RemstalWeg (Rems Valley Route) has magnificent views from its heights, and towns steeped in history in the valley below. There are numerous inviting circular hikes available. Six of these – the "Remstal Wanderschätze" – are award-winning, quality hiking trail "gems". And if you're aiming higher, you'll find climbing rocks and high-rope courses here, too.

Bike tours are also perfect for exploring the diversity of the Rems Valley's countryside with its vineyards, forests, natural orchards and river meadows. In particular the 106-km award-winning Remstal-Radweg (Rems Valley Cycle Route) links the region's highlights. In addition, the Rems Valley has MTB trails and BMX tracks.

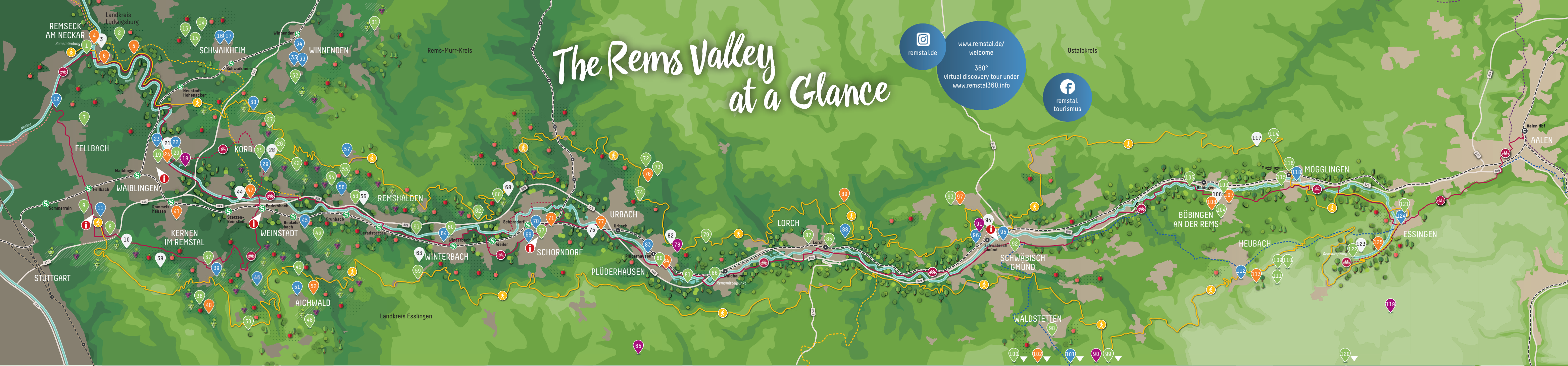
